WHAT I WILL STUDY

This course will equip you with the knowledge and skills to make evidence informed decisions about senior leadership. You will be confident in leading and supporting others to develop their practice, and skilled at implementing sustainable change across a range of areas like classroom practice, behaviour and culture, organisational management and working in partnership with others.

ASSESSMENT

There are two success criteria for the course:
