WHAT I WILL STUDY

This course will equip you with the knowledge and skills to make evidence informed decisions about classroom practice, curriculum and assessment design, as well as supporting you to implement meaningful and sustainable change.

ASSESSMENT

There are two success criteria for the course:

- Participation in at least 90% of the course
- Successfully pass the summative case study assessment

The summative assessment requires you to answer three questions in response to a case study. The assessment windows are set at the start of your course and there is an 8-day period to complete the assessment.
