#### WHAT I WILL STUDY

This course will help you develop skills and gain the confidence to enact changes in:

- setting a culture of high expectations and learning in your school
- enabling conditions for good behaviour for pupils and ensuring colleagues are supported in their classroom-level approaches
- supporting pupil wellbeing and understanding the impact this has on behaviour

#### ASSESSMENT

There are two success criteria for the course:

- Participation in at least 90% of the course
- Successfully pass the summative case study assessment

The summative assessment requires you to answer three questions in response to a case study. The assessment windows are set at the start of your course and there is an 8-day period to complete the assessment.
