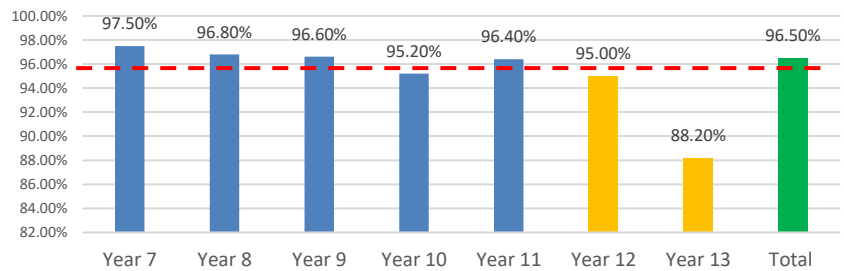
**8 families have now received penalty notices for taking their child/children out of school for a holiday. We will also continue to carry out spot checks/visits on absences longer than 3 days.**

### Number of Pupils who have 100% attendance this year

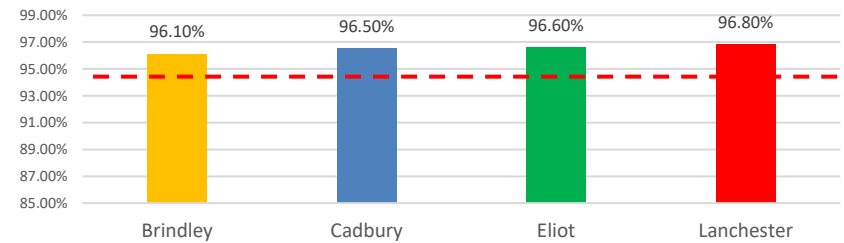

Well done to all those students who have still not missed any time in 14 weeks of school. All these students will attain an A4 Achievement point from the Headteacher

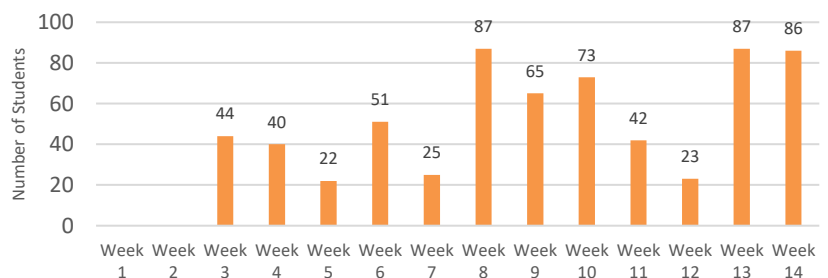
### Year Group Attendance - Week 14

### Let's Celebrate

- **4 Year 11 forms have an attendance of over 96%, and as a year group are at 96.4%, which is above our minimum expectation – this is vital in your final year, so well done.**
- **7L1** continue to have an attendance above 98% which is fantastic after nearly a term.
- **8L1** had 100% attendance in week 14 as well as **8L2** being at 99% - A further 9 forms were above 97%.
- **Year 7** still lead the way with an overall attendance of 97.5%, with the best house being **Lanchester** on 96.8%.
- **294 students** will receive a letter from Ms Rancins congratulating them on their 100% attendance in the first term – well done– all students will receive 8 achievement points.
- We do have 72 students who have an attendance of below 90% and are thus classed as persistent absentees. All families will be contacted in the new year. This is, however, an improvement of 40 students on the same point last year.

**Punctuality has been severely impacted in the last 2 weeks – we are aware this is becoming repetitive for 25 families in particular – we will be issuing fixed penalty notices to all these families if punctuality does not improve in the New Year.**

**We are also having a push on Year 10 attendance in the New Year. We believe that students are not coming into school without a valid reason and thus we will do spot check home visits on students whose attendance is poor, throughout the next term.**
